Submission of Self Study Reports: Self-Study Reports from the above institutions were submitted in accordance with the ECCE guidance and within the required timeframe. Due to the ENQA review and ESG compliance our accreditation processes are now transparent for the public. Chiropractic institutions accreditation results are now available on the ECCE website for public access and use. Students as members of an evaluation team appear to have worked well.

Evaluation Team Training

Evaluation team training took place in September 2014 as a webinar. This training was organised by the Chair CoA and the Evaluation Secretary. Seminars with attendance are expensive but are better for workshops. Online training (webinar, screencast) is cheaper but not as good for workshop activity. Executive will still explore the different opportunities for team training during the ECU convention. The format of the annual monitoring report has been reviewed in light of feedback from institutional stakeholders.

Recommendations for 2015:

- Finished the work on risk-based approach to periodic review.
- Explore possibility of face to face team training

3. Activities relating to ENQA and EQAR

The Vice-President has attended the ENQA General Assembly the 16-17 October 2014 in Zagreb, Croatia. The ECCE has more opportunities to attend to meetings and training via ENQA. This will help more ECCE staff to be familiar with the meetings. ECCE has prepared its own Self-Study Report to be used as the basis for an external evaluation by ENQA. ECCE membership is due for renewal in 2015 under the new ESG's.

EQAR

ECCE has been a full member of the European Quality Assurance Register (EQAR) since May 2013. EQAR's mission is to further the development of the European Higher Education Area by increasing the transparency of quality assurance, and thus enhancing trust and confidence in European higher education. EQAR seeks to provide clear and reliable information on quality assurance provision in Europe, thus improving trust among agencies. EQAR seeks to facilitate the mutual acceptance of quality assurance decisions and to improve trust among higher education institutions, thus promoting mobility and recognition. EQAR registration for ECCE expires between 1/1/2015 and 31/12/2016. This registration is directly linked with the review by ENQA.

4. WFC Education Conference
